FISCAL YEAR: FROM: JULY 1, 2022 to JUNE 30, 2023**

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget for the South Amboy Housing Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023 has been presented before the Members of the South Amboy Housing Authority at its open public meeting of June 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as presented introduced reflects total revenues of \$ 3,042,232.00 total appropriations, including any accumulated deficit if any, of \$ 3,063,390.00, and Fund Balance utilized of \$21,1580.00; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects total capital appropriations of \$720.000.00 and total fund balance planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$ 0.00; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rents, fees and other user charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be sued as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to spend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Members of the South Amboy Housing Authority, at an open meeting held on June 13, 2022 that the Annual Budget, including appended Supplemental Schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the South Amboy Housing Authority for the fiscal year period beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023 is hereby approved; and
